What is IAE?

The Integrated Award Environment

A centralized authoritative source for government award data

- Increases **transparency** into federal spending
- Reduces **reporting burden**
- Increases data **quality and integrity**
- Increases **accountability** in the award process





The IAE Systems

- 1.6 million average users per month
- \$1.1+ trillion in federal awards annually
- 5+ million average transactions monthly
- 527+ million page views monthly
- 45,000+ contract data reports per month
- Interface with 90 agency contract writing systems



- Over 900,000 pageviews worldwide since Opportunity transition (Nov, 2019)
- 120,000 currently registered users

Who We Are



- 637,000+ registered entities
- 55,000+ entities created or renewed each month
- 4.5+ million searches per month
- 147,000+ active exclusions




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IAE Modernization Timeline


- A single web application that requires a single user account.
- A single, more accurate search across all of our award data sets.
- A single, role-driven workspace to track all of YOUR award data.
- Searchable learning center with videos, glossary, FAQs, articles, alerts, and release notes.



- Data services providing award data in multiple formats including APIs and file extracts.
- Data bank providing formatted and adhoc reports
- Reference services for consistent data reporting (state, zip code, congressional district, NAICs, etc.)

IAE Modernization - Why “Beta”?

- **beta.SAM.gov** launched Q4 FY17, now operational
- Current operational systems will **run in parallel with the beta site** and will remain the authoritative sources until they’re decommissioned
- beta.SAM.gov will eventually **become SAM.gov**



Contract Data (FPDS) Reporting

- **Only FPDS Reports** are being retired - FPDS will remain the authoritative for SEARCH and DATA ENTRY
- New **reporting tool *MicroStrategy*** will be accessible through the Data Bank area of beta.SAM.gov
- **Static and Standard** report requirements are the same as they were in FPDS.gov
- **Ad Hoc reports** now have “wizard” and “build your own” capabilities
- **Conversion for existing Ad Hoc reports** from FPDS.gov to beta.SAM.gov completed with 85% success rate



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New/Improved Capabilities

- Reports can now span **12 years** instead of five
- Reports can now return **150K rows** instead of 30K
- Report structure can now be **easily shared** (attributes, metrics, etc)
- Additional reportable **Data Fields**
- Report **creation wizard**
