Contract Data Reports

Contract Data (FPDS) Reporting

Contract data reports capabilities are transitioning from FPDS.gov to beta.SAM.gov on **October 17, 2020**

- At that time, the FPDS reports module will retire and beta.SAM.gov will be the only place to create and run reports on contract data.
- All users should take advantage of this time to become familiar with the reports functions in beta.SAM.gov now, before the transition is final.



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Contract Data (FPDS) Reporting

- **New/Improved Capabilities**

- Reports can now span 12 years instead of 5
- Reports can now return 150K rows instead of 30K
- Ad hoc report structure can now be easily shared (attributes, metrics, etc.)
- Additional reportable data fields
- Select multiple PIIDs and organizations
- Wizard-like capability for ad hoc report creation

- **Transition Testing on beta.SAM.gov:**

- Reports transition testing began on March 16, 2020. Transition period ends October 17, 2020.
- 86% of ad hoc reports converted and are available.
- Training options include: [videos](#), [reference guides](#), and [FAQs](#).
