1	Our GSA Contract for Schedule 51V includes SIN 105-002 - Will you accept FSSI RFQ offers for SIN 105-002 or will the suppliers have to have all of the "Hardware Store Dept." SINS (105-001, 105-002, and 105-003) on their schedule? The only reason that I pose this question to you is because when GSA (Arlington, VA) sent out their RFQ's (ESCM-RFQ-122011) for Enterprise Supply Chain Solutions (4th Party Logistics "4PL" Program for the management of Brick and Mortar CES Storerooms), ONLY suppliers that had all three (3) SINS on their schedules could submit an RFQ.	The specific SINS that will be included under the Jan SAN RFQ will be announced at the Pre-Solicitation meeting which is May 15, 2013. Offerors will be required to quote on an entire pool. Currently, we have the JanSan pools set as follows: Cleaning compounds & Related Dispensers, Non-Motorized cleaning Equipment & Waste Collection Supplies, Paper Products & Related Dispensers, Motorized Floor Cleaning Equipment and Motorized Laundry Cleaning Equipment.
2	Will SIN 75-85 of Schedule 75 be part of the JAN/SAN RFQ?	The specific SINS that will be included under the Jan San RFQ will be announced at the Pre-Solicitation meeting, which is scheduled for May 15, 2013.
3	Will Schedule 56 be part of the MRO RFQ and will it be for all Schedule 56 SINS?	Yes, Schedule 56 is part of MRO but not all of the SINS will be included. The specific SINS that will be included under the Jan San RFQ will be announced at the Pre-Solicitation meeting, which is scheduled for May 15, 2013.
4	You stated that the JAN SAN will be divided into 13 Sub-Categories and I noticed that one of these sub-categories is "JanSan Fixtures" which include Sinks, Faucets, and other plumbing items. Therefore, will you please allow Schedule 56 SIN 563-25 "Plumbing Products and Bathroom Fixtures" to be included on the Jan San RFQ?	These items are covered by the MRO FSSI.
5	How many awards will be made for each FSSI?	This information will be released in our draft RFQ and discussed at the Pre-Solicitation meeting on May 15, 2013. 6	How will the awards be classified/structured? For instance, 2 awards to large businesses, 10 awards to small businesses, 2 awards to small disadvantaged businesses, etc., etc.	This information will be released in our draft RFQ and discussed at the Pre-Solicitation meeting on May 15, 2013. 7	Can you briefly explain what you mean when you say "Moving Spend from Retail to FSSI?"	Many agencies have service contracts to cover the janitorial and maintenance needs of their facilities. "Moving spend from retail to FSSI" is a goal to allow these service providers to buy their supplies, i.e.. floor cleaners, polishes, paper products, etc., from the FSSI solution to help the agency save additional money.
8	Is this BPA for all items on Sched. 73 or only JANSAN items?	Only JanSan items. For instance, food service items will not be part of the JanSan FSSI solution.
9	Has there been a draft of the JanSan RFP developed?	The JanSan team is working on a draft RFQ and plans to have it released prior to the Pre-solicitation meeting on May 15, 2013.
10	Have the results and findings been posted on the Industry One-On-One sessions?	The results of the One-on-One Industry discussions have not been posted but these discussions and the White Paper submissions have been used in the development of the business decisions for the acquisition.
11	Is there going to be another round of one-on-one sessions scheduled?	Additional one-on-one sessions are not being planned at this time.
12	What will happen to current BPA in effect?	Current BPAs will be left in place and if the item is covered by the FSSI solution, any remaining options will not be exercised.
13	What is the Small Business/SDVOSB plan?	This information will be released in our draft RFQ and discussed at the Pre-Solicitation meeting on May 15, 2013.
